

## WOBYC Information for Visitors

Before you come for your open meeting, here's a few things that are handy to know!

Car parking - the best way to get into the car park is to use the entrance opposite St Marks Church, Bridge Road, Oulton Broad. NR33 9JX. Drive through the car park until you see the dinghy park. You are able to drive down to the dinghy park to drop your trailer off, but please return to the car park ASAP.

You can pay for parking using the 'RingGO' app, or using cash.

You are welcome to leave your boat in the dinghy park overnight, although this is at your own risk. If you block somebody in, that's fine, but don't be offended if your boat gets moved slightly!

The slipway is right next to the dinghy park. It is a public slipway and is free to use. It's best to put your trolley back into the dinghy park when you've launched. Usually there's a friendly bunch of sailors around to help! In the summer, it can be busy with kayaks/paddleboards etc but they usually move out of the way. Finally, the slipway can be very slippery at low tide, please be careful!

The club is around a 200m walk through the park. Where there are changing rooms/toilets and a bar! Your open may have lunch included (check the NOR/Entry form) if not there are a number of takeaways (Pizza, Fish and Chips, Chinese, Kebabs, convenience store) very near by.

If you're staying overnight, there are several hotels/B&B's in the area. Including; Royal Norfolk and Suffolk Yacht Club, Broadlands Holiday Village and The Wherry Hotel. There is also a Premier Inn and Travel Lodge in Lowestoft.

Attached below is a map of the broads, showing the approximate position of the racing marks. Note, this is slightly outdated as Number 8 is now **light blue**! Full information about starts, courses, finished etc will be given at your briefing.

If you are traveling by boat, it may be possible to moor at the club overnight, but please contact us first!
