



# Notice of Race

## ITCA Wembley Traveller Nov 2024

### 1) Organisation Authority

- a) The organising authority is Wembley Sailing Club.

### 2) Rules

- a) The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024.
- b) Competitors shall sail in accordance with the RYA (Royal Yachting Association) Racing Charter
- c) Other than the matters included in this notice of race, no racing rule changes requiring advance preparation will apply. Racing rule changes will apply in full in the sailing instructions.

### 3) Eligibility and Entry

- a) The regatta is open to boats of the ITCA Topper class.
- b) Eligible boats may enter using this link:

- c) Entry will close on the 15<sup>th</sup> of November.
- d) Entry fee is £15 per sailor, payable via ITCA website (fee includes lunch for sailors at the clubhouse)
- e) All competitors must hold third-party liability insurance valid in the UK with a minimum of £2 million.

### 4) Schedule

- a) Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> of November 2024
  - i) 09:00 to 09:45 – Registration
  - ii) 10:00 – Sailor Briefing
  - iii) 10:55 – First warning signal
  - iv) Lunch at approximately 12:30 for 1 hour
- b) The Regatta will aim to sail 2 races in the morning and 2 races in the afternoon.
- c) The target time for each race will be 35 minutes and the time limit will be 50 minutes.
- d) No warning signal will be made after 15:00
- e) prize giving at 16h30 or as soon as possible after racing.
- f) The prize giving for the L&SE Autumn series and the 2024 series will also take place after this event.

- a) The race areas will be presented to the competitors at the sailor's briefing.

**8) The courses**

- a) The course will be presented to the competitors at the sailor's briefing.

**9) Scoring**

- a) The low-point scoring system will apply.
- b) 1 race shall be sailed to constitute a series.
- c) Once 4 races have been sailed, a sailor's worst result will be excluded from her overall score.

**10) Boats and Trailer Storage**

- a) It is the competitor's responsibility to either provide their own boat or to keep a club/borrowed boat in good condition to take part.
- b) Trailers must be stacked carefully, taking note not to obstruct any paths or slipways. Sailors must always follow instructions from the event team.

**11) Prizes**

The organising authority will award prizes at its discretion and will include

- a) Overall Event 1st ,2nd and 3rd
- b) 1st 4.2 sailor
- c) 1st Wembley sailor (outside of the above)
- d) 1st Female Helm (outside of the above)
