### Saturday:

- Gates Open at 8.00am
- Car parking at Castle Cove is limited, we will try to help everyone get a parking space at the club.
- Please note there is no camping or overnight staying at the club due to local bylaws
- All trailers, launching trolleys and boats must be dropped off in boat park, on arrival to ensure car parking spaces are used only for cars.
- Bacon rolls will be available on arrival.
- **Food will be available at lunch time, it will be pasta bake for a reasonable price. If you would like food, please let us know via the telegraph group before Friday.**

### Sunday:

- As Saturday for opening times and parking
- Sunday will be busy as it is also club racing, please bear with us on unloading boats and parking.
- Trailers will be dropped in front of the club and then parking will be in the car park. Rigging will then be either by the trailers or on the dinghy park.
- Registration from 9.00am on the balcony (in club house if raining!).
- Tally will be done at the top of the stairs where they will check that you have a buoyancy aid on and you will be ticked off the entry list.
- Launching and Recovery:  
We will have a Beach Team on hand for sailors whose parents are afloat or volunteering around the site. Trolleys will be then stacked by championship no. to aid recovery.
- Official Notice Board / Race office: The chart room window at the beginning of the balcony
- Bar: The bar will be open
- Galley: We have a help yourself tea and coffee system. There is an honesty tin for money. Tea & Coffee are 50p each. We do have a card machine. Minimum payment is £1.
- You are welcome to bring your own food and drink.
- Bacon & Sausage Baps will be available before sailing and food will be available after. If you could give an indication on the group if you would like food, that would be very helpful!

### Racing on Sunday:

- Racing will be run alongside our club racing. The topper start will be after the club race starts and the course will be different to the club racing course. The club racing will consist of 2 races in total and then these sailors will be heading in leaving just the toppers to complete their race series.

- Please rig boats in boat park, not in carpark.
- Changing Rooms, there are male and female changing rooms available under the balcony. Both sets of changing rooms are for all U18/18+ with a separate disabled changing area.
