REGISTRATION

Alongside the Club we have a white Marquee. Registration will take place here from 0830.

Don't forget your signed parent/guardian forms. These will be required in order to register and Talley be issued.

BRIEFING

The Briefing by the Race Officer will **commence at 0930**, followed by the Safety Officers Briefing. Competitors should assemble in the vicinity of the white Marquee prior to this time

TIDES AND TOWING

The tides for this event will be adverse, both leaving and retuning to the river.

We may tow all the competitors out to the race area and back to the launching area.

Depending on the various situations. Note, a rib could have up to 5 boats towing from each quarter.

Please ensure that you have a line of a suitable length for towing your boat.

Towing and how it will be carried out will be detailed at the briefing by the Safety Officer and the Beach master will assist and guide you on the launching point.

CLUBHOUSE FACILITIES

Changing and toilet facilities are available, the numbers may be managed. No Kit is to be left in the changing areas.

DIRECTIONS & PARKING


When coming into Hamble on the B3397, you will come to Hamble Square. Turn right down the cobbled street and follow the one-way road down the hill passing The Bugle on the right. Just past The Bugle, turn right, just past the foreshore car park there is temporary parking. Please pull up here and off load your dinghy and trolley from its trailer you will be met by the beach master who will show you where to put your dinghy.

Trollies must be clearly marked and easily identifiable with the boats sail number.

To make things run as smoothly as possible and as to not block the lane please unhitch as quickly as possible. Once you have dropped the boat and trolley off please move you car to the donkey derby field.

The donkey Derby field is approx. 200m up the hill on the left hand side just past the white row of houses.

Secure your vehicle and make your way back to the dinghy park. Hamble River Sailing Club is situated at the far end of the dinghy park, we are the last building past the Pink Ferry House at the end of the lane.
