



NS5 Rutland SC 2017 Final Preparations.

Arrival:

The gates will be open for you to drop off boats up to 9.30pm on the Friday evening. PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE LATER THAN THIS AS THE GATES WILL BE LOCKED.

The gates will re-open at 8.30am on Saturday morning.

Marshalls from the Club will direct you on arrival to where you should unload your boat, leave trailers and park.

Accommodation:

Registration:

In the Club House upstairs café area from 9.00am to 10.30am. Please make sure you print off and bring your registration form (these will be e-mailed to you on Wednesday). Double check that all the details are still correct (especially that we have the correct mobile number for the parent/guardian on site for the weekend).

Sited in the main Club House upstairs in the café area.

Café on site:

The café is open all day for hot and cold food and drinks.

PLEASE FILL IN A FORM IN THE RACE OFFICE WITH THE NAME AND MOBILE NUMBER OF THE ADULT ON SITE ACTING IN LOCO PARENTIS WHILST YOU ARE OFF SITE. REPORT BACK TO THE RACE OFFICE ON YOUR RETURN PLEASE.

Tally Board:

This will be located at the front of the Club.

You **MUST** collect your tally band before going afloat and only the sailor themselves can return the tally band when they come ashore.

Return your tally band **EVERY TIME** you come ashore, no matter if only for a brief time.

Tally bands are there to ensure the safety of all our sailors and there are much stricter rules/penalties being imposed this season for those who forget to tally in or out.

Dogs:

Dogs are not allowed on site.

Lowestoft and Nationals Sign Up to Volunteer:

We still have lots of gaps for help at these forthcoming events. It takes around 50 to 60 people per day to help at these events and we can't run them without everyone helping in some way.

If you haven't already signed up for a role and can help in anyway please come into the race office and speak with an ITCA representative, if you have already signed up...**THANK YOU...** but feel free to add yourself for another slot if you can!

Ribs:

If you are bringing a Rib to Rutland SC the Club Bosun will launch it if you arrive before 1730, otherwise park your rib by the Bosun's shed ready to be launched Saturday morning. All visiting rib owners must report to the club main office to complete a rib declaration form.

Prize Giving:

At every event there is a delay between the Race Office team setting up prize giving and it actually taking place. This is because the Class policy is that prize giving will not start until all the RIBs that volunteers/parents like you who haul around the country have been pulled out of the water and Toppers loaded on and tied down etc. The more people that help with this the quicker we start prize giving

Spot Prizes:

Spot Prizes are awarded at all events, remember if you are not there to collect the prize it will roll over for the next event. We are very lucky to have Harken supplying these items.
