Salcombe YC, Cliff House, Cliff Road, Salcombe, TQ8 8JQ Salcombe Yacht Club (salcombeyc.org.uk) will be open from 08.00 both days.

Launching to take place at Batsons slipway, This is about a 10-15minute walk from the clubhouse.

Cars, trailer and boats to park at Batsons Creek Carpark TQ8 8DU. The staff in the parking hut will help direct you. Your entry through ITCA includes a £10 charge which covers one days car and trailer parking and boat parking and compulsory harbour dues.

Any local boat that do not require the parking and harbour dues can request a £10 refund from Sean the ITCA SW area rep arearep.southwest@ITCA-GBR.co.uk Sean will be around probably wearing either a pink ITCA T-shirt or a light blue ITCA jacket.

Changing facilities at Batson are limited. There is a public toilet block nearby on Shadycombe Road just past the Coop, opposite the turning into Island Street. The club will be open for sailors to change prior to launching but please leave yourself enough time to return to Batsons if you want to change at the club.

Saturday - Training day

We have an excellent team of coaches RTG and ITCA 4.2 national squad coach Max Todd, supported by Mark Ripley and SYCs own Jayne Morris

Coaches to meet at club at 8.45 at club – then rib down to Batson

Sailors to meet Saturday 9.30 rigged AND changed. Max and his team will deliver an initial pre-sail briefing at the slip prior to launching. Depending on the conditions boat may be sailed to Smalls Beach where they will be carefully carried onto the beach opposite the club for further onshore coaching.

Sailors will come ashore for lunch and a rib taxi will be available to take sailors to SYC. Food and drink will be available at SYC, a kids special of Sausage and chips will be available for £5 alternatively food can be selected off the club menu.

After lunch there will be a briefing at SYC before a taxi / rib ride back to Batsons to launch for the afternoon sessions.

Sailors will return ashore to Batsons and a final debrief will be delivered either at SYC club house or the dinghy park
