

Joining Instructions for Open coaching and Traveller at Salcombe YC Sat. 9th- Sun. 10th September 2023

Salcombe YC, Cliff House, Cliff Road, Salcombe, TQ8 8JQ [Salcombe Yacht Club \(salcombeyc.org.uk\)](http://salcombeyc.org.uk) will be open from 08.00 both days.

Launching to take place at Batsons slipway , This is about a 10-15 minute walk from the clubhouse.

Cars, trailer and boats to park at Batsons Creek Carpark TQ8 8DU. The staff in the parking hut will help direct you. Your entry through ITCA does not include car and trailer parking and boat parking and compulsory harbour dues. Parking can be prepaid at Batson with the Harbour Office by calling 01548 843791

Changing facilities at Batson are limited. There is a public toilet block nearby on Shadycombe Road just past the Coop, opposite the turning into Island Street. The club will be open for sailors to change prior to launching but please leave yourself enough time to return to Batsons if you want to change at the club.

Saturday – Training day

We have an excellent team of coaches led by Mark Ripley, Issy Smith and SYCs own Jayne Morris, Mark McLaren and Jonathan Reynolds

Coaches to meet at club at 8.45 at club – then those who need to rib down to Batson, others will rig on Smalls.

Sailors to meet Saturday 9.30 rigged AND changed. Max and his team will deliver an initial pre-sail briefing at the slip prior to launching. Depending on the conditions boat may be sailed to Fishermans Beach where they will be carefully carried onto the beach not quite opposite the club but in front of Venus Café, for further onshore coaching.

Sailors will come ashore to SYC for lunch and a rib taxi will be available to take sailors to SYC. Food and drink will be available at SYC, a kids special of Beef or Veg Burger, Fish Fingers, Cheesy Beans on Toast or Chicken Nuggets all served with chips will be available for £7.50 alternatively food can be selected off the club menu.

After lunch there will be a briefing at SYC before a taxi / rib ride back to their boats to launch for the afternoon sessions.

Sailors will return ashore to Batsons and a final debrief will be delivered either at the dinghy park or the SYC club house

Sunday 4th Race day

The Race Officer will deliver a pre race briefing on the slipway before launching and hand out Race course cards

First warning signal will be at 10.30 and 3 races are scheduled back to back. Racing under Flag T. Please note there is a Laser Open as well and their first start is 10 mins ahead of the Toppers at 10.20

The prize giving will take place asap after racing. Weather permitting it is intended to hold the prizegiving at Batsons immediately after derigging.
