Arrival

The code for Gate Four will be 2418. The gate is accessible 24 hours a day with the code. This code is also for the pedestrian gate to the left of the main building entrance, although this will be open during the day. The pedestrian gate close to gate 4 has the code C1739 whilst the other pedestrian gates have the code C2013.

Dinghy Park (see the attached site plan for zones)

Please store your dinghies in the following zones.

Zones 3, 4, 5 & 6

Road Trailers

Please put road trailers in Zones 11, 12 or gravel car park

RIB Road Trailers

Please put RIB road trailers at the back of the gravel car park, behind the RIB compound. You may wish to bring a hitch or wheel lock to secure your trailer.

RIB Launching

Is from R3 Hard vehicle launching slipway. Please do not leave vehicles or trailers on the road leading up to the slipway as Sunseeker do require access.

Parking

All vehicles are to be parked in the **main gravel car park**, over the road, opposite the main building. Please keep the small car park free for windsurf users to access their slipway. **Vehicles are only permitted in the boat park to drop off and pick up boats.**

Reception

Lockers

Lockers are available. A **£10 cash** deposit is required to get a key, which are available from Reception.

Cafeteria

Water Refill Points

WPNSA encourages visitors to bring their own reusable drinking containers. There are four water bottle refill points: one in the Cafeteria, one outside the toilet corridor and two at the bottom of the Event Hall ramp. You will see these signs next to the refill points:



Dinghy Park – No Glass or Crockery
