REGISTRATION

Registration will take place from 08:30 inside the clubhouse

BRIEFING

The Briefing will **commence at 09:30**. Competitors should assemble in the clubhouse prior to this time.

SAFETY

Should a boat require assistance need towing please ensure that you have a line of a suitable length for towing your boat.

Please ensure your sailor has enough food and water for the length of time they will be on the water. Any rubbish can be disposed of in safety boats.

Each competitor will be allocated a tally band. This must be returned to the clubhouse when you come ashore.

CLUBHOUSE FACILITIES

Changing and toilet facilities are available. Please ensure that all kit is labelled, so any lost property can be returned to the sailors.

Food will be available in the club house before sailing, please fill the poll on WhatsApp. Payment at the bar.

PRIZE GIVING

Prize giving will take place at HRSC approximately one hour after the last race boat has been recovered.

DIRECTIONS & PARKING

When coming into Hamble on the B3397, you will come to Hamble Square. Turn right down the cobbled street and follow the one-way road down the hill passing The Bugle on the right. Just past The Bugle, turn right, just past the foreshore car park there is temporary parking. Please pull up here and off load your dinghy and trolley. You will be met by the dinghy park/beach master who will show you where to put your dinghy. If a road trailer is allowed in the dinghy park, it will be just to unload. It will need to be driven to the Donkey Derby Field as soon as unloading is done.

Trollies must be clearly marked and easily identifiable with the boats Championship Number.

Once you have dropped the boat and trolley off, please move your car by driving up green lane where you will reach the Donkey Derby Field on the left. Competitors are welcome to park here for the day. Please note the field will be closed at 18:00. Any double or triple stacking road trollies will also need to be moved to Donkey Derby Field to allow maximum space in the dinghy park for the Toppers.

Secure your vehicle and make your way back to the dinghy park. Hamble River Sailing Club is situated at the far end of the dinghy park, we are the last building past the Pink Ferry House at the end of the lane.

The Parish Council owns the dinghy park and accepts no responsibility for boats damaged, lost or stolen whilst on the foreshore.
