#### **Arrival:**

The Club will be open Friday evening until 8pm

Saturday morning normal opening is 0900hrs – but we are intending to open at 0830hrs.

# **Parking/Dinghy Park:**

There is ample room at the club for boats and trailers. Depending on the water level there will either be parking at the Club or on the adjacent Severn Trent Car park (free for this event)

#### **Accommodation:**

Unfortunately there is no overnight camping or staying on site (a condition of the lease from Severn Trent Water), however there is a campsite within walking distance of the club, look at <a href="http://www.knockerdown-inn.co.uk/caravan-camping/">http://www.knockerdown-inn.co.uk/caravan-camping/</a>.

There is also a field opposite the pub that has a campsite on it.

# **Catering:**
