

Arrival:

To avoid traffic jams, please follow the directions on the separate document which is also available to down load and pay attention to any requests made by the volunteer marshals. Please unload your boat and move your vehicle as quickly as possible on arrival and only bring your car to collect your boat/trailer once it is completely wrapped / loaded and is ready to hitch / put on the roof to aid a smooth get away for everyone. There will be security on the gates all weekend so you are welcome to arrive at any time BUT if you arrive after 6pm on Friday you will need to leave your boat/trailer in the lower car park until 7.30am on Saturday when you will be given directions by the marshals on moving iy up to the Dinghy Park.

Dinghy Spaces:

Your boats need to be put on the beach and gravel area on the south side of the club ENSURING THAT SLIPWAYS ARE KEPT CLEAR.

Registration:

Double check that all the details are still correct (especially that we have the correct mobile number for the parent / guardian on site for the weekend).

Café on site:

The café is open all day for hot and cold food and drinks.

Competitor Briefing Saturday:

10.00am for both fleets in the Windsor Suite. The 4.2 fleet will have a separate briefing after in Wet Room 2.

On Sunday the 4.2 fleet briefing will be at 09:30 in Wet Room 2. There will be no briefing on Sunday for the 5.3 fleet.

Tally Board:

This will be outside the Club building close as you come out of the changing rooms.

You MUST collect your tally band before going afloat and only the sailor themselves can return the tally band when they come ashore.

Return your tally band EVERY TIME you come ashore, no matter if only for a brief time.

Tally bands are there to ensure the safety of all our sailors and there are much stricter rules/penalties being imposed this season for those who forget to tally in or out.

Launching:

THE SLIPWAYS AT DATCHET ARE STEEP AND CAN BE VERY SLIPPERY SO <u>ALL</u> <u>PARENTS / HELPERS</u> MUST WEAR A BUOYANCY AID.

We desperately need parents to come in wet suits/dry suits/waders to help sailors launch and come back ashore Wellies will not be sufficient to help those struggling.

Please make sure that you DO NOT leave your boat on or near the slipways as this will obstruct safe launch/recovery for all. Remember too that we need to leave room to stack the empty trolleys near the slipways after launch.

Keep Warm:

Spring has officially arrived but the temperatures are still cold so come prepared with LOTS of layers, warm gloves (rubber gloves taped over normal woollen gloves work), hats, buffs and your dry suit perhaps (if you have one). DWSC operates a NO SKIN Policy which all sailors must adhere to.

Dogs:

NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED ON SITE

Prize Giving:

At every Event there is a delay between the Race Office team setting up prize giving and it actually taking place. Class policy is that prize giving will not start until all the RIBs are loaded, secured onto trailers and any Toppers packed away. The Event Trailer also needs to be loaded with all our Mark Laying and Race Office equipment. The more people that help with these tasks, the quicker we start prize giving.

Spot Prizes:

Spot Prizes are awarded at every event. Remember if you are not there to collect the prize it will roll over for the next event. We are very lucky to have Harken supplying these items.
