Arrival:

The gates will be open for you to drop off boats up to 10.00pm on the Friday evening. PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE LATER THAN THIS AS THE GATES WILL BE LOCKED.

The gates will re-open at 8.00am on Saturday morning.

Marshalls from the Club will direct you on arrival to where you should unload your boat, leave trailers and park.

Accommodation:

Motorhomes & Campervans can be booked into Poole YC for NS6 on a first come first served basis with Lorna Whitehead on 01202 672687 or via email lorna.whitehead@pooleyc.co.uk

Visiting Camper Vans (Max 8m Long):

£19.00	per night (Bund Wall, pre-booked / paid; no electricity)
£30.00	per night (Main Yard with electricity, pre-booked / paid)

Spaces are limited and need to be pre-booked and paid to the Club Office: a parking permit/space no. will be sent on receipt.

Car Parking:

Poole YC have organised car parking which is located in the public car park adjacent to the Ferry Terminal. Costing £14.00 for the weekend. Tickets are only available to purchase from Poole Yacht Club Office on Saturday morning and you will need a small plastic entry card which requires a £5.00 returnable deposit.

Registration:

In the "Skylight Lounge" accessed via stairs at the back of clubhouse from 9.00am to 10.00am. Please make sure you print off and bring your registration form (these will be e-mailed to you on Wednesday). Double check that all the details are still correct (especially that we have the correct mobile number for the parent/guardian on site for the weekend).

Located outside the Race Office underneath the Club Balcony.

Café on site:

The café is open all day for hot and cold food and drinks.

Tally Board:

Located at the rear gate beach entrance.

You **MUST** collect your tally band before going afloat and only the sailor themselves can return the tally band when they come ashore.

Return your tally band **EVERY TIME** you come ashore, no matter if only for a brief time.

Tally bands are there to ensure the safety of all our sailors and there are much stricter rules/penalties being imposed for those who forget to tally in or out.

Dogs:

Dogs are allowed on site and must be kept on leads at all times. Dogs are not allowed in the Clubhouse and you are asked to respect others by clearing up after your dog at all times.

Ribs:

If you are bringing a Rib to Poole YC the Club will be launching these on Saturday morning. For those of us arriving on Friday pm please park rib trailers where directed by club marshals. Please arrive with full fuel tanks as per class guidelines. Rib recovery will be discussed during the Safety briefing on the Sunday.

Prize Giving:

At every Event there is a delay between the Race Office team setting up prize giving and it actually taking place. Class policy is that prize giving will not start until all the RIBs have been loaded, secured onto their trailers and any Toppers packed away. The Event Trailer also needs to be loaded with all our Mark Laying and Race Office equipment. The more people that help with these tasks, the quicker we start prize giving.

Spot Prizes:

Spot Prizes are awarded at all events, remember if you are not there to collect the prize it will roll over for the next event. We are very lucky to have Harken supplying these items.
