



NS1 Plymouth Youth Sailing @ The Mountbatten Centre, Plymouth Sept 14/15 2019 Final Preparations.

Arrival:

You can arrive at any time after 17.00 on the Friday to drop your Topper off but volunteers from PYS will only be on site till 22.00 on that evening. After this time, you MUST report to the Centre Reception for location information.

PYS volunteers will be back on site from 0800 Saturday morning.

There will be two separate documents for you to download giving directions to the venue and a site plan which details where to keep your Topper and trailer over the weekend.

The area in the centre of the main car park and the small car park is strictly for Motorhomes only. All other vehicles must park in the public car park located on the South Side of the road as you approach the centre, after you have offloaded (see site plan).

Ribs:

If you are bringing a rib, this should be preregistered and can be launched from the main slipway at any time. Trailers are to be kept in the trailer parking area, on the south side of the road. (see site plan). Ribs once launched are to be moored on the Centre Pontoon, as instructed by centre staff.

Dinghy Spaces:

Toppers are to be stored as per the site plan. 4.2 fleet by the Western Slipway and 5.3 fleet in the main car/dinghy park, as directed by PYS volunteers. Trailers must be parked in the trailer parking area to the south of the main road. Please keep slipways clear at all times.

Registration:

Located in the classroom buildings in the main car/dinghy park adjacent to the motorhomes from 9.00am to 10.00am. Please make sure you print off and bring your registration form (these will be e-mailed to you on Wednesday). Double check that all the details are still correct (especially that we have the correct mobile number for the parent/guardian on site for the weekend).

Official Notice Board:

Is on the window of the classroom building where registration is held.

Café on site:

The café is open from 0900 all day for hot / cold food and drinks. If you are arriving on Friday night food will be available until 1900 and the club bar will be open till 2300.

There may be the opportunity of a meal on the Saturday evening. Further details to follow via social media.

Competitor Briefing Saturday:

Main briefing for ALL FLEETS will be at 10:30 located on the patio (inside Waterside Room if wet). This will allow us to get all relevant information and messages to everybody in one location.

4.2 competitors will have an additional briefing located in the Ocean Room on the Saturday morning. On Sunday briefing for the 4.2 fleet only commences at 09.30 in the same location.

Race Office:

Situated in the Classroom building in the main dinghy park. Pop in for:

- Laminated course cards (£1.00)
- Replacement Entry Forms (50p)
- Replacement ribbons if you lose yours! (50p)
- Replacement trolley tags (50p)
- Any general question/help

THERE MAY BE OCCASIONS WHEN ONLY ON THE WATER VOLUNTEERS ARE ALLOWED LOCO PARENTIS.**

Tally Board:

Located at the top of each slipway.

You **MUST** collect your tally band before going afloat and only the sailor themselves can return the tally band when they come ashore.

Return your tally band **EVERY TIME** you come ashore, no matter if only for a brief time.

Tally bands are there to ensure the safety of all our sailors and there are much stricter rules/penalties being imposed for those who forget to tally in or out.

Dogs:

Dogs are allowed on site and must be kept on leads at all times. Well behaved dogs are allowed in the Clubhouse and you are asked to respect others by clearing up after your dog at all times.

Prize Giving:

At every Event there is a delay between the Race Office team setting up prize giving and it actually taking place. Class policy is that prize giving will not start until all the RIBs have been loaded, secured onto their trailers and any Toppers packed away. The Event Trailer also needs to be loaded with all our Mark Laying and Race Office equipment. The more people that help with these tasks, the quicker we start prize giving.

Spot Prizes:

Spot Prizes are awarded at all events, remember if you are not there to collect the prize it will roll over for the next event. We are very lucky to have Harken supplying these items.
