

NS6 Carsington SC 2020 Key Information.

Arrival:

At present the water level at CWSC is extremely high. Therefore, there is limited room within the club grounds for you all to leave your boat and trailer. Club members will be directing you into the adjacent Severn Trent car park where you can offload your boat and leave your trailers.

The gates will be open for you to drop off boats up to 9pm on the Friday evening. PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE LATER THAN THIS AS THE GATES WILL BE LOCKED.

The gates will re-open at 8am on Saturday morning.

Car Parking:

There is a new system in place at Carsington for parking. Severn Trent are using Number Plate Recognition Systems for charging. It will be very important for CWSC to give Severn Trent all of your car registrations to avoid any unnecessary fines. CWSC will confirm before NS4 what these arrangements will be and what you will need to do.

Caravans / Motorhomes & Camping:

Motorhomes are allowed on site for NS4. Please contact the club direct on 01629 540609 to book your space. Please note this is restricted to 15 spaces only and will get booked up quickly. Unfortunately, there is no overnight camping on site, however there are numerous campsite's within walking distance of the club, one we would recommend is:

Registration:

Will be in the Club House from 9.00am to 10.00am. Please make sure you print off and bring your registration form (these will be e-mailed to you on Wednesday). Double check that all the details are still correct (especially that we have the correct mobile number for the parent/guardian on site for the weekend).

Official Notice Board:

Sited in the main Club House.

Café on site:

The café is open all day from 8.30am to 6pm for hot and cold food and drinks.

- EVERY SAILOR UNDER 18 <u>MUST</u> HAVE AN ADULT ON SITE ACTING IN LOCO PARENTIS AT ALL TIMES. IF YOU HAVE TO GO OFF SITE FOR ANY REASON, PLEASE FILL IN A FORM IN THE RACE OFFICE WITH THE NAME AND MOBILE NUMBER OF THE ADULT ON SITE ACTING IN LOCO PARENTIS WHILST YOU ARE OFF SITE. REPORT BACK TO THE RACE OFFICE ON YOUR RETURN PLEASE.

Tally Board:

This will be outside the Club building by the slipway.

You MUST collect your tally band before going afloat and only the sailor themselves can return the tally band when they come ashore.

Return your tally band EVERY TIME you come ashore, no matter if only for a brief time.

Tally bands are there to ensure the safety of all our sailors and there are much stricter rules/penalties being imposed this season for those who forget to tally in or out.

Dogs:

Dogs are allowed on site - dog owners need to make sure they clean up any mess. When food is being served they prefer not to have them in the Galley area.

Prize Giving:

At every event there is a delay between the Race Office team having set up prize giving and it actually taking place. This is because the Class policy is that it cannot start until all the RIBs that volunteers/parents like you who haul RIBs around the country for us have been pulled out of the water and Toppers loaded on and tied down etc.

I have been in your shoes, facing a 6 hour+ drive home with boats in tow and tired sailors on board and anxious to get on the road whilst still vaguely awake BUT if all those who have packed away their own boats headed off to the dinghy park again and helped the other parents with RIBs etc then we can speed the process up and get prize giving under way more quickly.
